The Delivery

- Teachers deliver our careers objectives through enrichment and PSHE lessons.
- Pupils experience careers sessions, workshops throughout the year and as part of our focus weeks.
- Visits and visitors form a large part of our curriculum giving pupils real life, authentic experiences.
- Employability skills are developed through job opportunities around the academy including School Council, Eco Committee and classroom monitors.
- A comprehensive transition programme is used to support year 6 pupils with moving onto secondary education- including visits to our main feeder secondary school for curriculum experiences.
- Children are offered a range of trips and workshops to support with higher education opportunities.
