

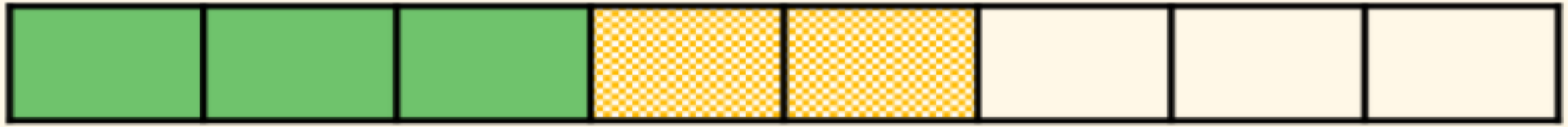

Boudicca Rebellion

Can anyone stop the Romans?

A major rebellion had started after Prasutagus, Boudicca's husband and former leader of the Iceni people died. At that time, the Romans, led by Paulinus, attempted to take over the tribe, and taking everything they can. An

Iceni tribesman, Aife, witnessed what was happening and he stated "The Romans have become monsters and are taking everything from us!"

Boudicca's army:

Boudicca decided to build an army to fight the Romans. She destroyed Colchester, which was an important Roman town. They also took over London and St. Albans. They had a variety of equipment from horse chariots, iron tip spears and war horns.

The Final battle:

Although they vastly outnumbered their enemy, the rebels were hungry and exhausted from previous battles. In addition, the Romans had superior

equipment and discipline. That said, Boudicca and the Britons are defeated. 80,000 Iceni lost their lives in the battle alongside just 400 Romans! "It was a blood-bath!" described one Iceni survivor, going on to explain they had no chance against the Romans.
