As they are mammals, they give birth to live young and feed them milk.

A baby dog is known as a pup or puppy until they are about one year old. A group of puppies born at the same time is called a litter.

Dogs are omnivores, meaning they will eat meat and plants (e.g. vegetables).

They have a remarkable sense of smell and use this sense to locate food, people or objects.

Some dogs are kept as pets and companions; others are used as protectors or as working dogs (specially trained to carry out many different roles).

It is believed that dogs have lived with people for at least 30,000 years! A fossil of a domesticated dog found in Belgium is thought to be from 31,700 years ago!

There are many different breeds of dog. Each of these breeds have slightly different appearances (such as size and colour), behaviours and life span. Some dogs have parents of the same breed (known purebred or pedigree). Other dogs' parents may be of different breeds (mixed-breed). This makes the official number of dog breeds difficult to calculate!

Dogs make different sounds to communicate, such as barks, growls, yelps, howls and whimpers. Each sound is made for a different reason and may be used to show they are excited, playful, hurt or scared.


