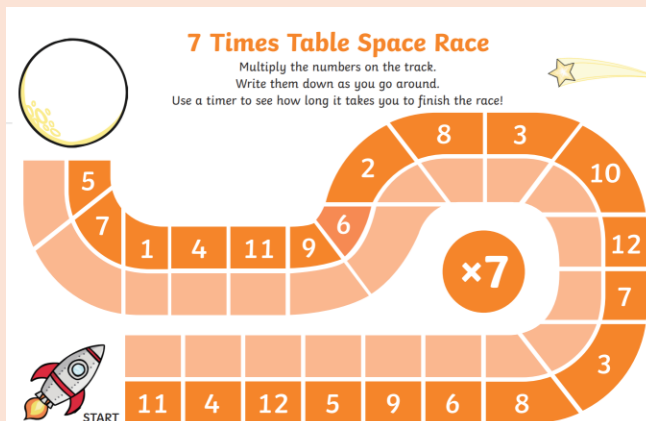
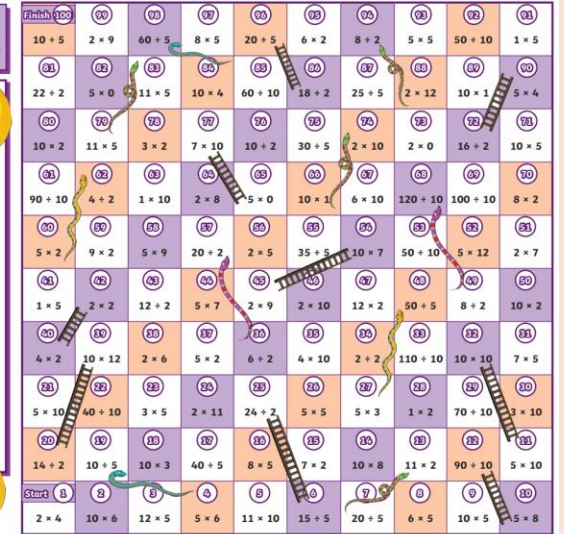
Snakes and Ladders 2, 5 and 10 Times Tables Facts

You will need:

- dice
- 1 counter per player

How to play:

- 1 Players take it in turns to roll the dice.
- 2 Each player moves their counter the number of spaces shown on the dice. If they land on a snake's head, they slide down to its tail. If they land at the bottom of a ladder, they go to the top of it.
- 3 Then, the player must answer the calculation they have landed on.
- 4 If the answer given to the calculation is correct, play continues as usual.
- 5 If the answer given to the calculation is incorrect, the player misses their next turn.
- 6 The first player to reach the finish is the winner!

Different Types of Writing

There are many kinds of writing, called *genres*. A **story** (or narrative) is written to entertain and has characters and a setting. A **recount** tells what really happened, using time words like *first* and *then*. A **report** gives facts about a topic. A **persuasive text** tries to make the reader agree or take action. A **poem** uses rhythm and rhyme to share feelings.
