



Lesson 5: Lesson statement

The key term in this lesson is **biodiversity**. Biodiversity is the variety of wildlife and plants in a particular habitat, such as the rainforest.






Which plants and animals live in a tropical rainforest?

Tropical rainforests support a wide variety of different **species** of plants and animals. This means that they have a high **biodiversity**.



Which plants and animals live in a tropical rainforest?

Each of these species are supported by food sources provided by the rainforest itself and the Amazon River, which flows through it. The different types of plants and animals have **adapted** to live successfully in the different layers.



Which plants and animals live in a tropical rainforest?

Rainforests, are home to over half of the world's plant and animal species. In the Amazon alone, there are:

- at least 40,000 different plant species
- 427 different types of mammal
- 1,300 different types of bird
- 378 different types of reptile
- 400 different types of amphibian.

It is also estimated that there are around 100,000 different invertebrate species.

Emergent layer

Animals found in the emergent layer are usually small enough to be supported by thin trunks and branches, such as monkeys who are good at jumping between the trees. Birds, bats, gliders, and butterflies also live in the emergent layer, as well as **predators** like white-tailed hawks and harpy eagles, who build their nests high in the trees and hunt animals from the layers below.



Canopy layer

The canopy layer is filled with fruits and so most animals live within this layer. The animals found here are: macaws, toucans, sloths, and howler monkeys, they are good at climbing. There are also thousands of insects in this layer.




Understory layer

The lack of light in the understory layer means that animals here are **camouflaged** from each other, which is useful for both predators and **prey**. Animals found in the understory layer of the Amazon Rainforest include snakes, insects, and leafcutter ants. There may be jaguars waiting to pounce from the forest floor too!



Forest floor

The largest animals live on the forest floor, such as armadillos, anteaters, agouti, rodents, and jaguars. They live alongside small **decomposers** such as termites, slugs, and worms, who break down the rotting leaves which have fallen from the trees.


